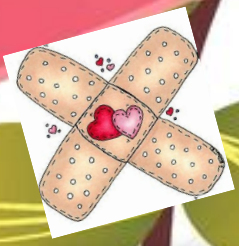

Women's History Month had its origins as a national celebration in 1981 when Congress requested the President to proclaim the week beginning March 7, 1982 as "Women's History Week". Throughout the next five years, Congress continued to pass joint resolutions designating a week in March as "Women's History Week". In 1987 after being petitioned by the National Women's History Project, Congress designated the month of March 1987 as "Women's History Month
