In celebration of this significant milestone, we have planned a number of fun filled senior activities. In order for your child to be eligible to participate in these specially planned events, your child is expected to demonstrate the following:

For your convenience, the cost of the Senior Dues can be covered by participating in the Hershey Candy Fundraiser:

For <u>each</u> box sold, \$25 will be applied to your child's Senior Dues expense (the balance covers the cost of the candy which goes to the Hershey Candy Company).

- Candy boxes will be distributed one at a time. As your child sells each box they must submit the total value of the box (\$60) prior to receiving a second box.
- If your child sells 9 boxes of Hershey Candy, \$225 (9 boxes \times \$25) will be credited to your child's Senior Dues, leaving a balance of \$0 to be paid.
